

Privacy Policy for Eraser

Your privacy is paramount. Eraser is built with a strict local-first philosophy. We do not sell, track, or share your personal data with third-party networks, analytics companies, or data brokers.

1. Integration with Apple Frameworks

Eraser operates directly on your Mac using native macOS frameworks to process your browsing preferences locally and securely:

Safari App Extension Framework: Eraser interacts with your browser strictly to hide or remove visual clutter in real time based on your active clicks.

Local Processing: The text, images, videos, and layouts of the websites you visit are processed entirely on your device. None of your web traffic, browsing habits, or page layouts are ever read, recorded, or sent to external servers.

2. Settings Synchronisation (CloudKit)

Eraser utilizes Apple's CloudKit infrastructure to keep your application preferences synchronized without collecting personal information:

Anonymised Data via CloudKit: Eraser uses Apple's CloudKit Public Database framework to store and sync your app configurations (such as your chosen activation states and layout options).

No Sensitive Content: The synced data strictly consists of anonymous application settings. Eraser never records, remembers, or syncs the web elements you have hidden, nor does it store your browsing history.

No Personal Information Shared: Your settings are entirely anonymised and decoupled from your personal identity. We do not attach or collect names, email addresses, hardware IDs, or any private identifiers.

3. Analytics, Advertising, and Storage

We protect your digital footprint across the board:

No Third-Party Analytics: We do not track your app behavior or feature engagement via external tracking software.

No Advertisements: Eraser features no ad networks, preventing third parties from building profiles about your usage.

Purely Local Execution: Because Eraser does not remember hidden items after a webpage reloads, no session data is saved or accumulated on your disk or in the cloud.

4. Your Rights and Data Control

Under standard privacy laws (including GDPR and CCPA), you remain in complete control of your data:

Revoking Access: You can completely disable the extension or modify its permissions at any time directly through your Safari Settings > Extensions panel.
